ver the past year, the Illinois Chapter of Acacia has made significant progress and achieved several milestones. In spring 2024, our suspension from being recognized by the University and Interfraternity Council expired and we were officially reinstated by both in the fall. We went on to welcome our largest pledge class since 2019.

Our suspension from the University's roster of fraternities presented several challenges, including decreased interest from potential new members and increased difficulty in planning events and partnerships with other Greek organizations. However, our previous executive board, led by Vice President Jack Wanless '23, worked hard to successfully petition for re-recognition. One of the key goals of our new executive board is to maintain a strong relationship with both entities to prevent future suspensions or disciplinary actions.

Our most successful fall rush since 2019 was achieved largely due to the dedication of our sophomore and junior classes. Led by former Recruitment Chairman **Anthony Petan '22**, we organized a full schedule of recruitment events, ultimately securing a 37-man pledge class—bringing us significantly closer to the pledge class sizes Acacia saw before 2019!

We can't wait to keep working hard and increasing our standing back on campus, and we thank all the alumni who helped us get to this point.



We look forward to continuing this tradition and hope to see a great turnout in 2025!


